

First Year	IELTS 6.0 (minimum 5.5)
Pre-Master's	IELTS 6.0 (minimum 5.5)

Please note: the College also accepts alternative English language qualifications such as GCSE English Language, TOEFL and PTE.

If you do not meet our English language requirements, you may choose to enrol on a Pre-Sessional English course with the Brunel Language Centre (BLC).
