
Below are the room types available on the College Lane Campus:

English language requirements

HIC programme	Required English language level
Foundation	IELTS 5.5 (minimum 5.5) or equivalent
First Year	IELTS 6.0 (minimum 5.5) or equivalent
Pre-Master's	IELTS 5.5 (minimum 5.5) or equivalent
