Standard Flats	Self-contained flat of up to eight bedrooms, each with single bed. Ensuite available.



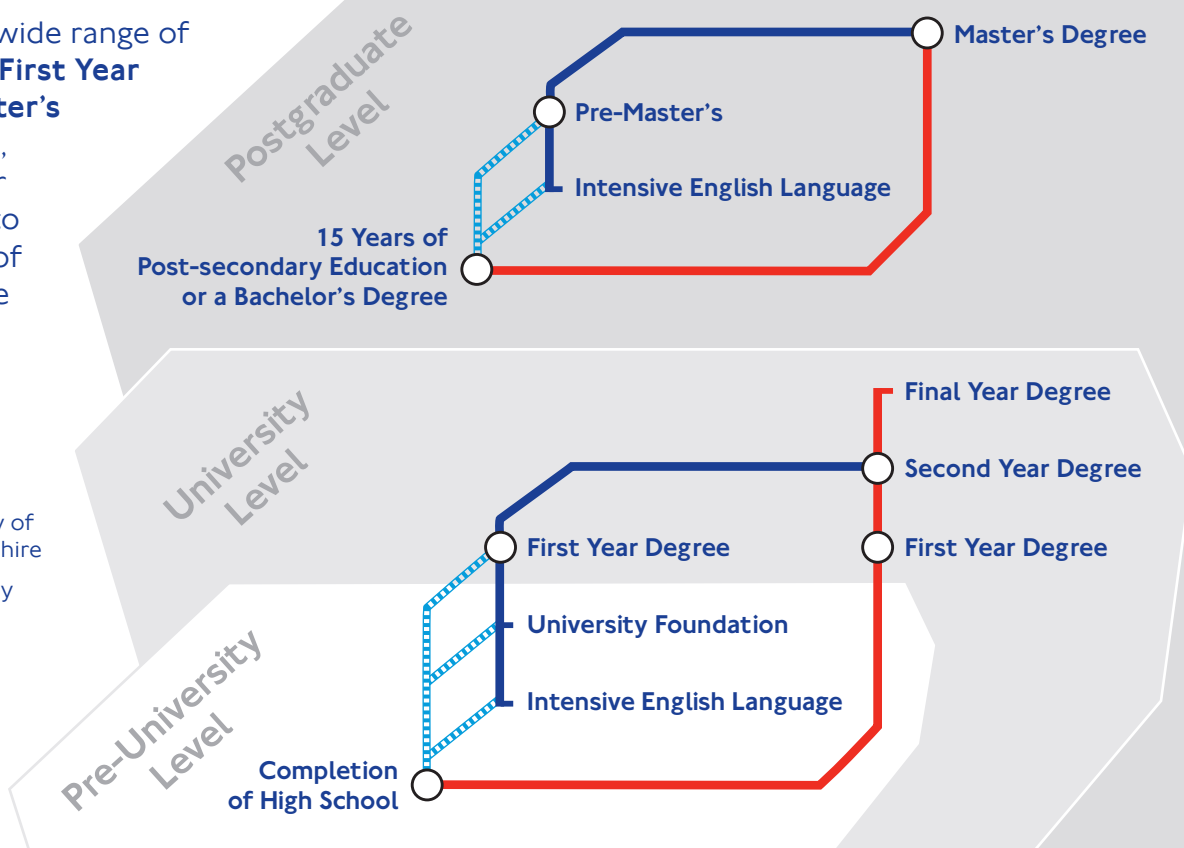
